Exhibitor/Vendor Terms & Conditions

Terms and Conditions (Continued):

3. In the event that an application is denied due to a lack of exhibit space, OICWA agrees to provide a full refund of the exhibit fee to the applicant. OICWA agrees to notify applicant of the unavailability of exhibit space no later than September 30, 2010 and provide a full refund within 30 days of notification.

4. Exhibitors and vendors are responsible for any damages to the hotel property, OICWA property, or the property of any prime contractor. Neither OICWA nor any prime contractor shall be responsible for any damages or losses incurred by exhibitors or vendors, including but not limited to theft or accidents.
